- 24.1 *Hypoxylon* up to 3 m  
to sign of furfuraceousness. Slight  
vibraceous texture to apical rim,  
texture ± white.
- 30.1 *Vibotella ciliata*
- Small white stipitate Coprinus, minutely wavy hair at  
flattened apex 200  $\mu$ m margin
- Asci 8 spored bisporic. Cylindrical clavate,  
slightly constricted below 40-30-35 x 8
- Spores ellipsoid. 4.5-5 x 3
- To sign if any pore looks operculate.  
No reaction with KI.
- water oil Spores with faint  
contractions.
- (Same to B Spores).
- 5.2. (Bipolar) Convers pores st. capitell,  
from below to 9-10. Asc blue in KI  
spores on small pile 17.7 x 11.2. gel sheath  
all round. Spores being infested by amoebae
- Ascobolus — pale 22.5 x 11.2. undulated gel  
glaucous.
